GUIDE FOR GUESTS AND PARTICIPANTS OF THE CCTT MEETING

- 1. Transfer from Mumbai International Airport to Aamby Valley Resort will be carried out from November 30, 2024 until 14:00 (local time). Those arriving after 14:00 will be accommodated free of charge at the SAHARA STAR Hotel, from where they will be transferred to Aamby Valley early in the morning on December 1.
- 2. Upon arrival in Mumbai, all guests and participants will be met at the exit of the airport by representatives of the Organising Committee of the event with "CCTT" signs.
- 3. Upon arrival at Aamby Valley, all guests and participants of the CCTT Plenary Meeting will be registered for the CCTT event upon receiving the keys to their rooms/houses.
- 4. Aamby Valley Resort is considered the most environmentally friendly territory in India. Here you can see about 120 species of birds, various kinds of animals, and, of course, monkeys. A big request to everyone: do not feed these charming animals, and, even more, do not pester them. When leaving your rooms, do not forget to close the windows and doors of the balconies in your rooms in order to prevent monkeys from entering your premises!
- 5. The period of stay at Aamby Valley Resort is the most comfortable time in India (air temperature +24 +28). But, given that a number of events will take place in open areas, we recommend taking with you: light jackets / sweaters / jumpers, comfortable walking shoes, stoles / scarves. International adapters for charging mobile phones will not be superfluous.
